As we head into January, our goal is to focus on attendance and student health. Please continue to monitor your child's symptoms for signs of fever, stomachache, headache, or sore throat. Students must be fever/vomit/diarrhea free for 24 hours without medication in order to return to school. See the information below for more details.

Winter weather is upon us! Be sure to <u>download the WCPS App</u> to receive notifications as they happen. PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE SCHOOL! We are notified when parents are, using the WCPS App. We appreciate your cooperation.

WCPS Board Policy has changed recently regarding early dismissal procedures for students. Effective immediately please send in a note with your child that morning if you are picking them up early. This allows for staff to prepare your child for the early pick up and is less disruptive to instruction.

#### Student Attendance

With cold and flu season fast-approaching, student health is of the utmost importance to us. If your child is sick (cold symptoms/flu symptoms/fever), please keep them home so they can get better! When they are well enough to return to school, please send a note to the office so we can excuse their absence.

If your child is exhibiting at least one Covid symptom, or you need advice from health staff, please feel free to reach out.

Our school automatically sends an attendance callout daily, as well as computer generated attendance letters at 6/9/12 and 18 days missed. Rest assured that if you have communicated with us regarding your child's absences, we will continue to work together to make your child's health as well as their school attendance a priority.
