Math MCAP Testing: May 4th, 9th, 10th, and 11th. ELA MCAP Testing: May 16th, 17th, 18th, and 23rd.

WCPS gives an award for Academic Excellence to deserving fifth grade students each year. Students who meet the criteria must achieve all performance indicators of 3's and/or 4's for each standard in all academic content (including Math, ELA, Science, Writing, and Social Studies) recorded on the report cards for MP2 and MP3 of fifth grade. Students must also achieve a 905 or higher on the spring eRI administered in grade 5. Eligible students will be recognized with a certificate from School Superintendent, Dr. Sovine. 

# KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION AND STUDENT ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

It's time to start planning for next year! Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten, and New Student Registration is open now! Please adhere to the following guidelines:

Pre-K Students: If your child turns 4 before September 1st, they are eligible for Pre-K for next school year. Please complete a Pre-K application by clicking <u>here</u>, or picking one up at school. Once approved by our Early Learning Department, you will sent a registration packet in the mail.

Kindergarten Students: If your child turns 5 before September 1st, they are eligible to enroll for Kindergarten! Registration packets are available by clicking <u>here</u>, or you may pick one up

during school hours.

New Student Enrollment: If you are just moving into our district, please contact us to inquire about which documents you may need to enroll. You may also download the registration packet by clicking <u>here</u>.

\*Please note: Cascade is a ten-month school and only has summer hours by appointment. To register for an appointment, you may complete this <u>form</u>.

All forms and requirements must be met before the enrollment process is complete, so start today!


Our next PTO meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, August 1, 2023 at 1:00 pm, in person or via Google Meet. We hope to see you!




# CHARACTER COUNTS AWARDS


These six pillars are: *Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring and Citizenship.* These characteristics are very important to the growth of our children today.

Early Release Procedures during the School Day

WCPS has recently amended the policy that will <u>only</u> allow a release of student during their instructional day with a parent note. The parent or guardian must provide written notice to the school if a student is to be released during the school day. No blanket notes will be accepted. The note must identify the <u>name of the person</u> who will be picking the student up. The person picking up the child MUST have their <u>photo ID</u> when coming to the school. In the event of an emergency, please contact the school to make arrangements. As always, you may email Mrs. Kandi with your early dismissal note as well at <u>woostkan@wcps.k12.md.us</u>. Thank you for helping us keep your child safe!





School doors open at 7:35 a.m. The tardy bell rings at 7:55 a.m., tardy students must be signed in by a parent/guardian. Student dismissal is at 2:25 p.m.


Upon arrival either by bus or private transportation, all students will enter through the cafeteria doors when they open at 7:35 am. Students arriving by car before 7:35 am, must park in the parking lot as the bus loop will be unavailable to cars until 7:45 am.

After the tardy bell rings at 7:55 am, all students and visitors must enter the building through the main entrance. Students arriving late must be signed in by a parent/guardian.

Student dismissal is at 2:25 pm. Please do not pull into the bus loop until all four buses have pulled through first. Students will be brought out to cars and released to parents after the buses leave.

\*Please note: Cascade Elementary along with its staff is a ten-month school. This means that the school is closed for snow days and summer break unless by appointment. If you need assistance you call the school at 301-766-8066.





Washington County Public Schools has a policy which allows the Cascade Elementary School attendance area to either be delayed, closed, or to dismiss early, in the event of inclement weather. This zone was determined by the conditions in the higher elevations surrounding Cascade Elementary School affecting elementary, middle and high school students. With the increased attendance area, it is important to clarify who is affected by a decision to implement a schedule change due to inclement weather in the area identified as the Cascade Mountain Weather Zone (CMWZ).
