Cascade Elementary End of Year Reminders



- The last day of school is <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>June 7th</u>. This is a half-day for students. We will dismiss at 11:55 am.
- Please be sure to pick up all medications from the health room by <u>June 3rd</u> before 3:00 pm.
- Report cards will be mailed home the week of <u>June 20th</u>. Please be sure your address is correct with the front office.
- The office is closed during the summer. Please call the school to schedule a visit.

Preparing for next year...

- The first day of school is Monday, August 29th. Please notify the school if your child will be out that first week of school for any reason.
- Please plan ahead for your child's dismissal for next year, and be sure to send a note with them on their
 first day of school. Note: bus routes and teacher placements will be posted on the front windows the
 week before school starts.
- If you know your child will be riding a bus someplace other than to/from your home, a Transportation Location Change Form will need to be completed. These forms are available online, and will take 10 business days to process.
- As a reminder, the WCPS Handbook & Guide and Policy JEDB states that a written notice from the student's parent or legal guardian must be submitted to the building's principal or their designee in order for the student to be dismissed from school before the regularly scheduled dismissal time. Individuals, including emergency contacts who are not the parent or legal guardian, <u>must present a signed note to the school</u> from the parent or legal guardian before the school will release the student to the individual. The school will verify the identity of the individual picking up the student by asking for a photo identification.
- <u>All visitors</u> will be required to present photo ID each time they visit the school. Students will not be released to anyone without proper identification.
